Board of Directors' Meeting - DMC Conference Room – September 9, 2013

Meeting Called to Order: Greg Reed called the meeting to order at 5:33 P.M.

Approval of Meeting Minutes: Minutes of the August 12, 2013 meeting were reviewed and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Sam Losapio reported interest of \$.03 for a current balance of \$3,545.85

Sign Report: Brackets for 20 signs and flared leg brackets for larger round posts have been purchased. Current sign inventory consists of 4 old style (Masked Burglar) and 20 new style (Boris).

Adjustments & Addition to the Agenda:

Old Business:

- Training Video – Melvin Buckner reports that the video is nearing completion.

New Business:

- Mary Wozny submitted a proposed change to the Standard Operating Procedure for signs as follows:
 - Current
 - The board will supply “Boris” street signs with reflective coating to groups with out charge for the first sign. These signs will be placed at the main entrance of the neighborhood. The board will also replace at no cost any sign that is faded, or damaged. If any group wishes to have additional signs, the board will supply them at cost. New signs will be ordered when ten (10) remain in inventory.
 - Proposed
 - The board will supply Neighborhood Watch street signs to groups without charge for the first sign. These signs will be placed at the appropriate location for the qualifying group. If any group wishes to have additional signs, the board will supply the signs at cost. The board will also replace any sign that is faded or damaged at ½ cost, if the neighborhood group still qualifies. New signs will be ordered when ten (10) remain in inventory, unless there is evidence of a large demand for signs.
